

Inedible Beef Tallow

APHIS only certifies tallow not produced under FSIS supervision. The product description must note that the tallow is “inedible.”

The material must be exported on a VS Form 16-4 stating:

This is to certify that rinderpest, foot-and-mouth disease, classical swine fever, swine vesicular disease, African swine fever, and contagious bovine pleuropneumonia do not exist in the United States of America.

Certified materials have been tested and found to have a level of insoluble impurities of 0.15 percent or less.

This certification must NOT be provided on the basis of an affidavit.

Other certification requirements have not been determined.
