### **VI. CERTIFICATION STATEMENTS**

**A.** The animals originate from USA or a part/state in USA, which has been free from Foot and Mouth Disease, Classical and African Swine Fever during the last twelve (12) months preceding the date of export.

**B.** The animals originate from farms that were free of Porcine Reproductive and Respiratory Syndrome (PRRS), Transmissible Gastroenteritis (TGE), Porcine Epidemic Diarrhea, Porcine Enzootic Encephalomyelitis, Swine Vesicular Disease, Aujeszky's disease, Leptospirosis and Brucellosis for at least six (6) months preceding the date of export. No case of Postweaning Multisystemic Syndrome (PMWS) or Porcine Dermatitis and Nephritis Syndrome (PDNS) has been diagnosed in the farm at least six (6) months preceding the date of export.

**C.** The animals have been examined prior to departure and found to be clinically healthy and showed no evidence of infectious or contagious diseases at the time of export.

**D.** No fodder, feed or straw were taken on board the shipment from any intermediate port/airport during the time the pigs to which such declaration refers to were on board the ship/aircraft.

## VII. TESTING

The swine were tested as prescribed below, have been tested with a negative result for the following diseases in the last month before their departure. All tests were performed at a laboratory acceptable to USDA.

**A. Brucellosis** - by buffered *Brucella* antigen test (specifically, the card test) **OR** tube agglutination test at a 1:50 dilution.

**B. PRRS** - by immunoperoxidase monolayer assay (IPMA) **OR** indirect fluorescent antibody (IFA) test at a 1:20 dilution **OR** ELISA.

**C. Leptospirosis:** (MAT) or less than 1/100 or farm certified free of leptospirosis serotype Pomona, tarasovi (hypos), canicola and icterohaemorrhagic; **OR** treatment dihydrostreptomycin at a dose rate of 25mg/kg bodyweight within seven days of export **OR** long acting oxytetracycline at a rate of 20mg/kg at an interval of 14 days with the last treatment seven days before the export **OR** have been vaccinated with a Leptospirosis (5 way) vaccine.
