SUBJECT: Availability of Genetic Sequence and Isolate

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Notice is to furnish interested parties with the genomic sequence from the recent H5 clade 2.3.4.4b highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) virus. This Notice also informs interested parties that the isolate is available for purchase from the National Veterinary Services Laboratories (NVSL) only to entities approved and registered for HPAI virus with the Federal Select Agent Program (FSAP).

II. BACKGROUND

This was developed in response to the recent emergent issue in dairy cattle. Please refer to <u>Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) Detections in Livestock</u> Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (usda.gov)

III. ACTION (or POLICY)

Veterinary Services can share the genomic sequence and isolate availability due to collaboration from our National Animal Health Laboratory Network (NAHLN), including Texas A&M Veterinary Medical Diagnostic Laboratory and other Texas State animal health partners, the Animal Health Diagnostic Center at Cornell University, and the Iowa State University Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory, to encourage disease research and development to benefit the U.S. dairy industry.

No Material Transfer Agreement will be required; however, as above, the material may only be transferred under FSAP procedures (i.e., a <u>Form 2</u> shipment) to a registered entity. Associated fees for the isolate and shipment under FSAP guidelines will be borne by the requestor. This isolate is <u>not</u> a pre-tested Master Seed; it is being made available for research and development.
