SUBJECT: Change in Distribution Policy for Memoranda and Notices

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Notice is to inform interested parties the Center for Veterinary Biologics (CVB) will no longer mail hard copies of newly released memoranda and notices.

II. BACKGROUND

Currently Veterinary Services (VS) Memoranda and the CVB Notices are available electronically. The CVB also prints and distributes paper copies of newly released notices to approximately 222 different organizations. In an effort to reduce our paper usage and assist in cost-saving measures, the CVB has opted to maintain the website version and discontinue the mailing of hard copy documents.

III. ACTION

As of the date of this Notice, the CVB will cease distributing hard copies.
