SLF 2024 V2 Quick Reference

IMPORTANT!! You must synchronize your map at the beginning/end of each workday. FOR ALL DATA ENTRY:

- Open ArcGIS Field Maps. Confirm correct ArcGIS Enterprise URL.
- 2. Open previously downloaded map area & stand at the point you wish to collect.
- 3. Tap the Layers icon & toggle ON the layers you wish to view/edit.
- 4. Tap the blue plus sign in the lower-right corner of the map to add data.





Add data button

Egg Mass Monitor Points

- 1. Choose the Egg Mass Monitor Points 2024 layer.
- 2. Complete the data form, check entries, and tap Submit.

**Every Monitor Point entry must also have an Activity entry of: Establishment/Treatment

Egg Mass Monitor - Activities

- 1. Tap the push pin symbol on the map to select it.
- 2. Scroll down and tap Egg Mass Monitor Activities or tap the link icon.
- 3. Tap the blue Add button.
- 4. Complete the data form, check entries, and tap Submit.

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Activity / link icon

Egg Mass Treatment Areas

- 1. Choose the Egg Mass Treatment Areas 2024 layer.
- 2. Tap the blue Add Point button to record each corner.
- 3. Complete the data form, check entries, and tap Submit.

Site Plans

**Site Plan geometry can only be altered (changed or add new) by a Field GIS Specialist

Edit data

To edit attributes in the main Site Plan data form or in the Site Plan Activity record:

- Tap to select the parcel, confirm the parcel from the offered name to the left, and tap to open the associated data form.
- 2. Scroll down and tap Edit or tap the pencil icon.
- 3. Carefully enter the data changes and tap Submit.

Record a Site Plan Activity

- 1. Tap the area symbolized on the map to select it.
- 2. Confirm the parcel from the offered name to the left and tap to open the associated data form.
- Scroll down and tap "Site Plan Activities" or tap the link icon.
 Tap the blue Add button and complete the activities data form. Verify the Activity Date field is Today.
- 4. Complete the data form, review your entered data carefully and tap the Submit button in the upper right corner.

Trapping

Place a Trap

- 1. Tap "New Trap Site".
- 2. Complete the data form, check entries, and tap Submit.

Trap Activity

- 1. Tap the trap symbol on the map to select it.
- 2. Scroll down and tap "Trapping Activities 2023" or tap the link icon.
- 3. Tap the blue Add button.
- 4. Complete the data form, check entries, and tap Submit.

Relocate a Trap

- 1. Trap Activity: "Trap Activities 2023" Remove > Submit
- 2. Transport the trap to its new location and perform "Place a Trap" steps as above.

Treatment Points

- 1. Select the Treatment Plan (Herbicide, Insecticide, Mechanical Removal, or Unassigned)
- 2. Fill out the main data form.
- 3. Review your entered data carefully and tap the Submit button to save the new survey record.

Treatment Areas

Record the Treatment Area

- 1. Select the Treatment Plan (Herbicide, Insecticide, Mechanical Removal, or Unassigned)
- 2. Tap/drag and tap Add Point until the area is completely drawn (green check flashes)
- 3. Complete the data form (Verify the *Assessment Completion Date* field is Today.)

 * Asterisks indicate mandatory fields.
- 4. Review your entered data carefully and tap the Submit button in the upper right corner.

Record a Treatment Area Activity

- 1. Tap the area on the map to select.
- 2. Scroll down on the form and tap "Treatment Area Activities" or tap the link icon.
- 3. Tap the blue Add button and complete the activities data form. Verify the *Treatment Date* field is Today.
- 4. Review your entered data carefully and tap the Submit button.

Visual Survey

- 1. Select the pest status (Positive, Negative, or Undetermined) and complete the data form. Verify the *Survey Date* field is Today.
- 2. Review your entries and tap the Submit button.

Wetlands

- 1. Tap to select the Wetlands symbol from the list on the left.
- 2. Tap/drag the map and tap Add Point until the area is completely drawn (green check flashes)
- 3. Complete the data form..
- 4. Review your entered data carefully and tap the Submit button.

Map Notes Points / Areas

Not program required. Located within the Reference Layers group.

NOTE: These layers are meant to share information or hazards to all surveyors

NOTES:

If the Submit button fails, you have not completed all required fields or GPS accuracy failed.

To preserve battery power, put the device to sleep between surveys.
