The following certification statements must be included in the "ADDITIONAL DECLARATIONS" section of the VS Form 16-4. These statements should not be modified.

This is to certify that rinderpest, foot-and-mouth disease, classical swine fever, swine vesicular disease, African swine fever, and contagious bovine pleuropneumonia do not exist in the United States of America.

This office has on file a notarized affidavit from [company] verifying the accuracy of the statements below.

- 1. The product has been subjected to a heat treatment of at least 74°C for 60 minutes where the internal temperature throughout the product reached at least 74°C.
- 2. The product has been heat processed in a manner designed to destroy all microbiological pathogens of concern, including Avian Influenza Virus, Salmonella, E. coli, Enterococci, Clostridium and Listeria spp.
- 3. The product was processed under sanitary conditions including precautions to prevent contamination of the product with pathogenic agents after processing.
- 4. The product was packaged using new or sterilized materials and properly stored, and precautions have been taken to prevent contamination prior to export.

In the "PRODUCT" section, include "Fertilizer, avian origin" and specify the species of origin. The "IDENTIFICATION" section should include the lot/batch number.
