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Certification Statements:

1. The animals have a microchip implanted, which conforms to ISO standard 11784, and reader to ISO standard 11785, OR the animal has a microchip implanted which does not conform to the standard and the pet owner will provide a microchip reader to enable the microchip to be read successfully upon entry.

2. The animals were vaccinated against Rabies using an inactivated and adjuvanted vaccine approved by the Veterinary Authority of the exporting country, no less than one month (30 days) prior to export. The vaccine was administered when the animals were at or over 12 weeks of age, and after the microchip was been implanted.

3. A blood test to determine the Rabies antibody titre (Fluorescent Antibody Virus Neutralisation test (FAVN) was carried out by an approved laboratory, with blood drawn at least 30 days after the date of the Rabies vaccination. The test yielded a titre equal to or greater than 0.5 IU/ml. NOTE: Your pet will not be allowed entrance until 3 months have passed from the date that your vet took the blood sample which led to the successful results. The original copy of the laboratory results must accompany the Health Certificate.

4. The animals were examined within 14 days prior to export, and were found in good health and free from symptoms of any prescribed or any other infectious or contagious diseases, and are free from external parasites.

5. The animals were treated for endoparasites, including tapeworm, with approved broad-spectrum anthelmintics and for ectoparasites, including ticks, not less than 14 days prior to export.

6. If any dogs are included in the shipment, they have been inoculated for Canine Distemper, Leptospirosis, Hepatitis/Adenovirus, Parainfluenza, and Parvovirus not less than 14 days prior to exportation.

7. If the shipment includes dogs, they have tested negative for Heartworm, Lyme disease. Sampling for tests were taken no more than 14 days prior to export.
 Note to importing official: Testing for Leishmaniasis was not completed because it is not endemic in the U.S. pet population. Testing for Nipah virus and/or Hendra virus was not completed because this disease is not present in the United States.

8. If the shipment contains cats, they were inoculated for Feline Leukemia, Feline Rhinotracheitis, Feline Calicivirus, Feline Panleukopenia and Feline Pneumonitis no less than two weeks (14 days) prior to exportation.

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OTHER INFORMATION: An import permit is required to enter St. Lucia; Arrangements for Import Permit must be made in advance to travel date. Dogs/cats must be transported directly into St. Lucia and should not be in contact with any other animal on the flight except those for which similar permit has been issued. Animals failing to meet Import Requirements or entering without a permit will be refused entry or be humanely euthanized. The Veterinary and Livestock Services Division must be notified of your port of entry, date, time and flight number at least three days in advance of your arrival date.
