- 4. During the 12 months prior to collection, the farms of origin of the donor animals have been free of clinical cases of scrapie, maedi-visna, caprine arthritis/encephalitis, bluetongue, paratuberculosis, ovine epididymitis, and contagious agalactia.
- 5. On the day(s) of collection, all the donor animals were in good health and did not show clinical signs of infectious or communicable disease.
- 6. The semen was collected, processed and stored in a manner that is acceptable to the USDA at an APHIS-approved semen collection center, which is inspected annually, and the center is under the supervision of the USDA Accredited Veterinarian.
- 7. Only animals that have completed a 21 day pre-entry isolation and are associated with semen production are permitted to enter the center. The semen collection facility has separate areas for the pre-entry isolation of animals.
- 8. The donors are adequately isolated to prevent the transmission of diseases from farm livestock and other animals.
- 9. The semen has been diluted using diluents that do not contain pathogenic organisms and to which antibiotics have been added in accordance with OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code recommendations.
- The semen straws are individually identified with donor animal and collection identification code.
- Semen was stored in containers which were new or cleaned and disinfected with a licensed product.
- The shipping containers will be sealed by USDA accredited veterinarian prior to transportation to the port of embarkation.
- Semen was not exported prior to the final endorsement of required veterinary health certificate by the competent veterinary authority.
