Guidance on Export of U.S. Origin Livestock and Animal Genetics

As of November 2019, Ukraine requires imports of livestock (except domestic, sport, experimental, circus animals, as well as animals intended for exhibitions and entertainment), and their reproductive material to come from Ukrainian-approved facilities. There are three ways that a U.S. facility is approved for export of livestock or animal genetics to the Ukraine:

- The U.S. facility is approved by Ukraine, and on the "<u>List of countries and facilities from which it is possible to import live animals and reproductive material into the customs territory of Ukraine</u>," translated and abbreviated here:

- The U.S. facility is listed in the European Union (EU) Trade Control and Export System (TRACES):
 - a. Bovine embryos
 - b. Bovine semen
 - c. Swine semen
- The U.S. facility has previously exported successfully to the Ukraine between April 4, 2013 and April 4, 2018

NOTE: If your facility is not listed on the approved Ukrainian list, does not have an EU-approval number, or did not export from the United States to Ukraine between 4/4/2013 and 4/4/2018, your Ukrainian importer will need to work with the Ministry of Agrarian Policy and Food of the State Service for Food Safety and Consumer Protection in the Ukraine, to initiate the process of Ukrainian approval.
