2. The country was free from the following diseases for the twelve (12) months prior to collection:

- (i) Swine vesicular disease (SVD)
- (ii) African swine fever (ASF)
- (iii) Classical swine fever (CSF)

3. The donors were kept in a collection center where no clinical cases of the following diseases were officially reported for sixty (60) days prior to collection:

- (i) Porcine brucellosis (Brucella suis)
- (ii) Rabies
- (iii) Trichinellosis
- (iv) Atrophic rhinitis
- (v) Porcine cysticercosis
- (vi) Transmissible gastroenteritis (TGE)
- (vii) Teschovirus encephalomyelitis
- (viii) Porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS)
- (ix) Tuberculosis
- (x) Porcine epidemic diarrhea (PED)
- (xi) Vesicular stomatitis virus (VSV)

4. For Swine Brucellosis (B. suis), the animals for export:
