Moving firewood can spread
emerald ash borers or Asian
longhorned beetles hidden inside.
Always leave Hungry Pests behind.



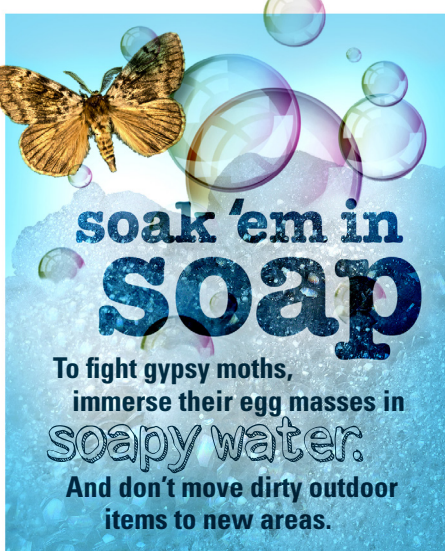
Dirt and mud can give insects and their
eggs a free ride. **Clean tires**
and **wheel wells** before going to
or leaving from a camping trip.



Invasive pests can hide in mud and dirt.
Always clean shoes, boots and gear
before and after enjoying time in nature.



DON'T BRING BACK
flowers, plants, leaves or other souvenirs
of nature. They might hide invasive pests.



To fight gypsy moths,
immerse their egg masses in
soapy water.
And don't move dirty outdoor
items to new areas.



Only use firewood that was
either responsibly harvested
near the place you will burn it
or labeled as heat-treated.

a vital line of defense against invasive
